


## Sheridan Metropolitan Board of Police Commissioners

Minutes from the May 24, 2022 meeting of the Sheridan Metropolitan Police Commissioners.


- All members were present: Silas DeVaney, Steve Fisher, and Steve Leonard. Also present were Town Advisor Todd Burtron and Town Attorney Beth Copeland.
- Si DeVaney opened the meeting at 5:01 p.m. and called for everyone in attendance to stand and recite the pledge of allegiance.
- First matter of business was to open for nominations for officers;
  - DeVaney made a motion to nominate Fisher for President; Leonard seconded the motion; passed unanimously
  - Fisher made a motion to nominate DeVaney for Vice President; Leonard seconded the motion; passed unanimously
  - Fisher made a motion to nominate Leonard for secretary; DeVaney seconded; passed unanimously
- Second matter of business was an explanation of the police commission's roles and responsibilities as outlined in IC 36-8-9-4; Copeland and Burtron informed the commission, answered questions and a discussion was held.
- Third matter of business discussed was how to proceed with the oversight of the police department pending more formal decisions by the commission. Copeland and Burton suggested to the Board that they vote to maintain status quo until the commission convenes to make more formal decisions regarding the appointment of the police chief and qualifications for all officers.
  - DeVaney made a motion for the police department's appointed ranks to remain status quo; Fisher seconded the motion; passed unanimously.
- Meeting adjourned at 5:24 p.m.


