


BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS  
OCTOBER 30, 2017  
SHERIDAN TOWN HALL  
PUBLIC HEARING AT 5:30 P.M.

The Board of Zoning Appeals met Monday, October 30, 2017 at 5:30 P.M. at the Town Hall. Members present were Glen Bougher, Bob Halcomb David Kinkead, Connie Pearson and Beth Lee. A quorum was present. The meeting was opened by President Bob Halcomb. Mr. Bougher made a motion to approve minutes from the last meeting. Mrs. Pearson seconded the motion. All members present voted to approve. Motion carried.

A Public Hearing was held for docket number 17-SE-01. Application submitted by Henry B. Lewman Jr. The property located at 1009 South Georgia Street in Sheridan. He would like to have a Hair Salon in the garage of the home. The Public Hearing was advertised in the Noblesville Times. All adjoining property owners have been notified by certified mail. Mrs. Pearson ask about if they would put up a sign. Mr. Lewman said no sign would be put up. This shop would be by appointment only. They have not over 12 customers a week. There is parking and an entrance for the shop. Mrs. Pearson ask how much equipment was in the shop. Mr. Lewman said 2 chairs, a hair dryer and a sink. Deborah Crist was present at the meeting and wondered why she did not receive a notice about the hearing. Mr. Halcomb explained her property is not adjacent to 1009 S Georgia Street so they would not receive a notice. A motion to approve docket number 17-SE-01 was made by Mr. Bougher. Mrs. Pearson seconded the motion. All members voted yes. Motion Carried. The Public Hearing was closed. Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Halcomb. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Lee.
