Sheridan's Redevelopment Commission (RDC) offers a matching grant program for facade improvement to commercial properties located on Main Street between 1st Street and 10th Street. Application for a grant is a two-step process including completion of an Interest Inventory followed by a formal application complete with detail design and vendor quotes for work to be done. Following review of the Inventory by the SFIG Organizational Committee, a formal application will be provided to the interested property owner.
