1. Introduction

Todd Burtron began the meeting with introductions of The Committee.

Todd Burtron introduced Banning Engineering.

2. Redistricting Process

Banning Engineering presented information to the Committee regarding the redistricting process. The focus was to gain an understanding of the science behind the methodology of redistricting. Banning Engineering discussed the current map of the districts and what they will look at when creating new districts.

They follow two main rules:

Close to equal population in each district.

All districts remain continuous.

Banning Engineering will be sending the Town and Township the census data that they have for approval. Once that data is approved, Banning Engineering will create new drafts of district maps to present to The Committee by the end of February.

The Committee plans to present the information received from Banning Engineering at a Public Meeting in March 2024.

3. Public Meeting

The Committee has received positive feedback regarding the last public meeting.
